

Ganga Sagar Transport Management Plan – 2021

- Around 450 nos. of local small vehicles will be engaged in the Sagar Island for carrying pilgrims from Kachuberia to Sagar and Benuban to Sagar.
- Around 25 nos. of local buses will be engaged for carrying pilgrims in the Sagar Island.
- 180 nos. of Private buses and 30 mini-buses will be transshipped from mainland to Sagar Island by 08.01.2021
 - Around 210 nos. of buses will be deployed from Kachuberia to Sagar.
 - 30 nos. of Mini buses and 6 trekkers will be deployed from Chemaguri to Sagar.
- 68 nos. of Buses will be deployed for carrying N.G.O.s from Kolkata to Lot 8 and back.
- Same services will be provided to NGOs at Sagar Island as well.
- 10 nos. of buses will be deployed for shuttle service from Lot 8 to Namkhana.
- 7 nos. of buses will be deployed for shuttle service from Raichak to Lot 8 / Namkhana.
- 2200 nos. of STU buses will be engaged for carrying pilgrims from Princep Ghat / Babughat / Esplanade to Lot 8 / Namkhana.
- 75 nos. of Ambulances will be handed over to the CMOH, Diamond Harbour for providing emergency Trauma Care Management Service.
- Train Service – in addition to regular local train service, additional trains will be deployed from Sealdah to Namkhana and Princep Ghat to Namkhana.
- Around 100 nos. of BLOA launches will be deployed for carrying pilgrims from Namkhana to Benuban / Chemaguri.
- 32 numbers of launches of Hooghly Nadi Jalpath Paribahan Samabay Samity & WBTC will be deployed for carrying pilgrims from Lot 8 to Kachuberia.
- In addition to normal barge service, 4 additional large vessels will be deployed for transshipment of vehicles and pilgrims during Mela period.
- 41 WBTCL buses will be deployed for carrying Media Personnel, NIS, Red Cross Society, CD Volunteers and other Officials of Infrastructure Cell.
- Speed Limiting Device (SLD) of all 235 buses and mini-buses will be re-calibrated @ 40k.m./hour.
- 15 Speed Laser Gun will be installed along the stretch of Kachuberia to Sagar.
- 30 no. of breath analyzer will be used for breath test of the driver.
- Around 600 drivers and khalasis of bus and mini-bus deployed at Sagar Island will be trained for maintaining safety majors.
- 3 Camp Offices will be functioning along the stretch of Kachuberia to Sagar and 6 flying squads team will be deployed to monitor vehicles movement.
- Movement of all 235 buses will be monitored through GPS tracking system.
- P.A. system will be installed in all 235 buses at Island, 100 wooden Launches, 32 Vessels and 6 Barges.
- 75 Jalasathies and 200 Sagar-Bandhu will be deployed.
- 10 Break-down Van will be deployed.
- Two Air-ambulances and three Water Ambulances will be deployed at Sagar during Ganga Sagar Mela-2021.
