e) Quarantine Centres –Eight (08) nos. of Quarantine Centres (QC) having bed capacity = 705 at different points will be set up for accommodating direct contacts of COVID Positive patients during Mela period. In addition, there will be dedicated pilgrim sheds at all the 5 major points of Ganga Sagar for quarantining pilgrims. 2. Medical screening of Pilgrims, Officers and Staff deployed:

Medical Screening along with Vaccination Status checking will be done mandatorily of each & every Pilgrim. will be done by the thermal Gun Check up by the well-trained Civic Volunteers/ Health staff in all the Health facilities including buffer zones & First Aid Centres Starting from OutramGhat to Sagar Island (approximately 110 kms distance).

However, where indicated, Rapid Antigen Testing (RAT) facilities will be manned by the Civic Volunteers, Health personnel. Dedicated sample collectors (from the existing resources and from few outsourcing) will be deployed. The report will be available on spot by the DEOs deputed from the BSKs. <u>In Our District the numbers of Nine (9) prominent locations</u> have been identified where all pilgrims will pass through. The locations are as follows...

3. Sample Testing of the Pilgrims:

All the above cited health facilities will be manned by the existing LTs (of the respective District) and the DEOs and there should be provision of on-line entry.

In any case, suspected Symptomatic cases must not be allowed to move forward and to be kept in nearby isolation centres. And in Symptomatic RAT negative cases need to be referred to the RT-PCR centers. RTPCR Testing will be done in two labs, viz. SSKM Hospital and DHMCH. The sample will be collected only in special cases and that to be collected at the earmarked Health facilities. A coordinated system will be in place for Hassel free sample collection, transportation, report collection & tracking the patients and interim safekeeping of such pilgrims.

i) Sample test (RAT) will be done for those only who will be found to be symptomatic during medical screening at different entry points / Buffer Zones, Bus Stands, Railway Stations. Online data entry arrangements will be in place.

- ii) If the person is found to be positive after RAT, he along with his / her team will be taken care as per COVID Protocol. If any symptomatic patient is tested negative, he / she will be referred for RTPCR Testing Centre. There will be mobile van to collect the sample from the person at the point of medical screening camp.
- iii) If the person is found to be positive after RTPCR, he / she will be shifted to the nearby Safe Homes / SARI isolation ward / COVID Hospitals as recommended by the MO. They will be marked as "Tested Positive" after test. His / her teams being the primary contacts will be detained in nearby QUARANTINE CENTRE.
- iv) There will be dedicated ambulance for transporting the persons to the nearby Safe Home / SARI isolation ward / COVID Hospital.

4. Maintaining social Distancing:

Everywhere along the route from Babughat to Kapil Muni Temple, Social Distancing will have to be maintained with the Mask on all the time. Especiallyin the sea beach and in the Kapil Muni Temple, Social Distancing norms have to be ensured andshould have to be strictly followed and it will be monitored mainly by the Police Administration. Special civic volunteers, Civil Defence and the other staff may be engaged to watch and to help maintainsocial distancing norms in every Bus / Train / any other vehicles/ any other mode of travel, Violation of which may strongly be dealt with by the police administration.

5. Mask & Sanitizers Distribution:

Everybody should wear mask; and sanitization activities will have to be arranged in the Bus Buffer zones like Babughat; Railway stations (like Sealdah; Diamond Harbour; Lakshmikantapur; Kakdwip& Namkhana) and special Kiosk may be arranged for IEC and automated Sanitization will be worth doing in every entrance of the stations and bus-stand and in every gate of the Health Facilities. Mask and sanitization have to be distributed in every buffer zone where more & more numbers of pilgrims will conglomerate. In this regard, 50 no. of Automated Sanitization machines are required.

6. Checking of Vaccination Status & vaccination:

It is needless to mention that, in this present scenario, every pilgrim must have to show their completed vaccination status to the volunteers, otherwiseit will be difficult for us to allowthem to move towards Sagar Island. However, stat RAT test negative pilgrims may be allowed to move forward. In the Sagar Mela 22, it is of no use to vaccinate the incoming pilgrims; rather we have to ensure 100% vaccination of the Sagar Island and the habitant people of in and around the route to Kapil Muni Temple from Babughat to avoid chance of infection.

7. Sample testing of people deployed on duty:

All the staff and officials deployed for Ganga Sagar Mela 2022 will be instructed to get their test done at their work place within 72 hours before reporting for duty.

8. Modus operandi of Ambulances deployment :

In all the RAT testing facilities cited above must have to equipped with 102 Ambulances and such no. of Ambulances in DHHD are as follows

Also we will require at least 3 <u>dedicated 102 ambulances</u>@ every Safe Home in DHHD totalling tenno of 102 Ambulances during the Mela Period between 7th of January, 2022 to 18th of January, 2022. Apart from that, 75 ambulances will be deployed in different places like last year from DM Pool.

9. Green Corridor identification:

A separate Green Corridor

- 1) In the Mela Ground Hospital Road NO 3;
- 2) ChemaguriBenuban ferry Ghat approach road; and

- 3) In the Kachuberia Ghat for quick & hassle free transferring of the emergencyas well as Covid positive patients to be set up like previous year and that too <u>it will be extremely better if these areas are maintained</u> strictly by paramilitary forces.
 - 4) A green corridor has been identified in Lot-8 through which patients will be transferred to the Kakdwip SSH smoothly like last year.

10. Transferring the Covid positive patients to the safe Homes:

i) Safe Homes- Already Total seven (7) nos. of Safe Homes (having bed capacity = 605) have identified, Seven in the DHHD having bed capacity = 365 and One in the South 24Pgs Health District having bed capacity = 250. All the facilities as per guidelines of the H & FW Dept. will be made available in these

Safe Homes for the pilgrims. A dedicated safe homes need to be identified in the Kakdwip for the staff deployed in the Sagar Mela duty.

From the entire RAT testing facilities the Positive cases will be transferred to the nearest safe Homes depending upon the conditions of the patients.

11. Transferring the Covid positive patients to the Covid Hospitals:

The Distance from the OutramGhat to Lot -8 Temporary Hospital is 83 Km (approx); and the Covid Hospitals available in this Road are:

- a) Bangur Hospital (500 bedded Capacity)
- b) Diamond Harbour Government Medical College (200 bedded Capacity)
- c) Kakdwip Temporary Covid Hospital (80 bedded Capacity)

From the entire RAT testing facilities & from the safe Homes, the Positive cases will be transferred to the nearest Covid Hospital depending upon the conditions of the patients & availability of Bed.

12. Special Attention to the Paediatric age group Covid positive patient :

This year, Paediatric age group positive patients are expected; hence, we have prepared the following measures,

Availability of the Paediatric CovidBeds in DHHD (Total 92 Beds):

- 1) Diamond Harbour Medical College (Bed capacity for paediatric patients, NICU= 25 beds; PICU= 10 bed; and SNCU = 12 beds. Therefore, **Total = 47 beds**).
- 2) Kakdwip SDH & SSH (Paediatric bed capacity = 30 beds)
- 3) Apart from that, Rudrangar Hospital will run with 10 paediatric beds.
- 4) Temporary Mela Ground Hospital will have special Arrangement for 5 paediatric ICU beds.

13. Caring of SARI cases.

In addition, this year we will keep dedicated 10 bedded SARI isolation ward to be set up at Temporary Sagar Mela Ground Hospital and another 10 bedded SARI isolation ward at Rudranagar Hospital &Five(5) bedded SARI ward to be set at Kachuberia Temporary Hospitalwith Cardiac Monitor, pulse-Oxymeter and dedicated oxygen cylinder and other accessories. Additional two cell counter, Electrolyte analyzer, full auto and semi auto analyzer are needed for Sagar Mela ground Temporary Hospital and Sagar RH.

14. Contact Tracing

Once a person is tested as COVID POSITIVE, his direct contacts will be traced. All the direct contacts irrespective of symptomatic or asymptomatic will be retained in nearby QUARANTINE CENTREs and will be checked for COVID-19 symptoms. Sample collection and testing will be done only if required.

15. Disposal of the Dead bodies:

A dedicated Burial Ground and a crematorium have been identified at the Sagar Island and similarly, another same set up will be identified at the Kakdwip Sub-Division. We have already identified the same in the Diamond Harbour Sub-Division. All the health care facilities will be well connected by mail, whats-app or by HAM Radio through which, the information will besent to the dedicated Team for disposal of the Covid Dead body through Hears Van.COVID body packaging and funeral related manpower to be identified at Sagar Island and Kakdwip SD Hospital.

16. Hears Van deployment:

COVID related Dead body carrying Hares Van = 2 nos. at lot8 and 2 nos at Sagar mela ground to be kept ready.

17. Water and Air Ambulance arrangement:

Dedicated Water Ambulances (speed Boat) at least three (3) in numbers are required for quick transportation and referring the Covid positive patients from Sagar Island to the main land for advance treatment. Two (2) water Ambulances for Kachuberia to Main Land and One (1) water Ambulance from BenubanFeeryGhat to Main Land.

We require Two (2) Air-Ambulancesto be set up during the period of Sagar Mela, 2022 for the Covid positive patienttranportation.

18. Insurance Claim:

As per existing protocol, it will be processed by the respective in-charge either of the safe Homes or of the Covid Hospital and ultimately by the concerned department for settling of the claim.

19. Sanitization

Sanitization of pilgrims at medical screening camps, bus stands, railway stations, temple entrance and jetties to be done. Installation of sanitizing tunnel / paddle sanitizer / auto sanitizer / hand sanitizers are also to be done at strategic points.

Daily sanitization of all buffer zones (Medical Screening Camps), railway stations, bus stands, jetties, barricades, Mela Grounds, Temple area, pilgrim sheds, NGO Sheds and all other sheds, temporary VIP Sheds, Circuit Houses, Mela Offices, beach area, shops, hotels, Control Rooms, Safe Homes, Quarantine Centres, COVID Hospitals etc to be carried out.

Sanitization of buses, launches, autos, ambulances and all other vehicles used for pilgrim transportation after every journey will be done. **The Fire Brigade Dept. and the respective PanchayatSamity will ensure the sanitization**. The services of the NGOs and CDVs will be utilized.

20. Biomedical Waste Management:

Our existing Vendor, Genentech will be given the additional charges for the safe Homes and temporary Hospitals. Bio medical Waste Management for Covid -19 pts to be taken care of by the health Department though the necessary payment will be made as per existing norms and by the General Administration.

21. Communication Management:

All the activities will be coordinated by the apps, Ham Radio and walkie-talkie and the CC TV surveillance and through interdepartmental net work. All the entrusted personnel's contact no will be shared to each other for faster communication.

Apart from this a dedicated control room to be set up for 102 Ambulance in Kachuberia. In case a Covid pt.needs to be transported to the main land from Kachuberia, the Covid pt. within the ambulance in situ may be transported to main land through barge.

22. IEC Activities:

Since from Last year, the Ganga Sagar Mela is being organized with a challenging situation, massive IEC will be done from every department. The Leaflets, Posters, Banners, Radio jingle, street play, milking, announcement in different languages and displays will be of immense beneficial as well as protective.

23. COVID Material Management Plan:

Like last year, we will COVID Material Management Plan assess the requirements of different materials and instruments like thermal guns, masks, sanitizer, PPE, testing kits, etc for all officials and personnel to be deployed by them and for different facilities like Safe Homes, SARI isolation wards, COVID Hospitals and all other facilities and arrange to procure them before the Mela for smooth health services and COVID management.

The NDC will assess the requirements of different materials like, masks, sanitizer, etc for all officials and personnel to be deployed by different depts. and arrange to procure them before the Mela for smooth functioning of health services for containment of spread of COVID-19. The materials will be distributed at different points as per requisition received from the Point In-Charge

24. Management of NGOs and Volunteers:

In addition to their regular services, the NGOs, CDVs and other volunteers will be deployed at medical screening camps, bus stands, railway stations, jetties, barricades, mela ground and temple ground to impose sanitisation, wearing masks and maintaining social distances in queue like previous year.

Their services will also be utilized for IEC at medical screening camps, bus stands, railway stations, jetties, barricades, mela ground and temple ground for distributing leaflets, masks and hand sanitizer and for maintaining social distances in vehicles and launches and in Safe Homes and QUARANTINE CENTREs for providing food and other services. They will be trained properly to provide different services at different locations.

25. Covid Control Room, Call Centre & Information Management:

Dedicated COVID Sub-Control Room will be established within the main control room at Mela Ground. Dedicated COVID Call Centre to be manned by separate teams – 24X7, to be led by one DMDC, one police Officer - not below the rank of DSP, one MO – not below the rank of ACMOH A dedicated toll-free Help Line No. also will be established.

A dedicated COVID-19 Control Room will be established at all major points - one BDO, one police Officer - not below the rank of ASI and one MO. They will coordinate the information, transportation, admission, disposal of dead bodies of COVID POSITIVE patients. They will guide the SARI / ILI / Co-Morbid patients, specially, to the isolation ward with special care and keep track. They will coordinate in disposal of any complaint. They will keep contact with the families of the patients. They will share information with other districts and other states, if required.

26. Rapid Response Team (RRT):

A dedicated rapid response team will be patrolling every time in the Sagar Island. In case of any exigency, the team will rush to the spot in no time and will provide emergency medical management. The said team will be

consisting of physician, Surgeon, orthopedician, public health specialist (epidemiologist) and support staff. They will be constantly keeping contact with the control room and point in-charge of the temporary hospitals.

27. IT Application:

Separate software for tracking the movement of COVID POSITIVE pilgrim of GS Mela will be prepared like previous Mela. The pilgrims may be tracked from the stage of medical screening till they reach home after being recovered from COVID POSITIVE.

The entry will be done at Medical Screening Camp, Quarantine Centre, Safe Home, SARI Isolation ward, COVID Hospital and Control Room. Dedicated DEOs will be deployed at all such points. They will be trained for handling of this software.

28. Arrangement of Training and deployment of Human resources:

Phase by phase of different kind of training will be arranged considering the type of job the Human Resources will be deployed in the month of December 2021.
